SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Mars Hill Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) — a non-profit established by Mars Hill Academy to award scholarships exclusively to MHA students — is dedicated to advancing the Kingdom of Christ by helping more families experience a classical, Christ-centered education. As required by Ohio law, the SGO prioritizes students from qualified low-income (QLI) families, defined as those whose household income is below 300 percent of the poverty threshold published by the United States Census Bureau (listed on the back of this form for 2024). Additionally, students or their guardians who receive public assistance, as outlined in section 5101.26 of the Revised Code, are considered QLI applicants.

All families submitting a tuition assistance application via MHA's Blackbaud Financial Aid Management are automatically considered for an SGO scholarship. Such families should not complete this form.

All families requesting consideration as QLI for SGO priority must submit a tuition assistance application via MHA's Blackbaud Financial Aid Management. Such families should not complete this form.

All families completing a Mars Hill SGO application via this form will be categorized as non-QLI and understand that priority consideration will be given to QLI applicants as required by law.
